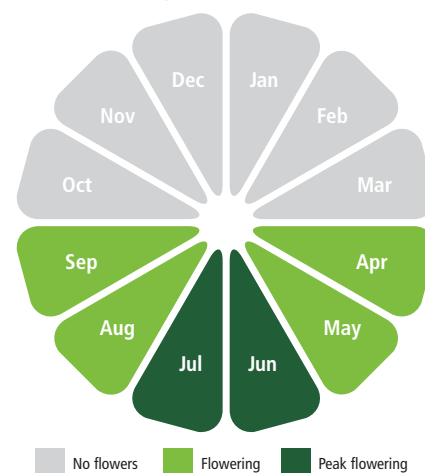


Specifications: Sedum Trays

- **Available from** www.turfonline.co.uk
- **Standard Size** 0.25m² - 4 trays required per square metre
500mm wide (19.6")
500mm long (19.6")
100mm deep (3.9")
- **Weight** 18kg – saturated weight may be up to 22kg
- **Vegetation height** On despatch is approx. 50mm (1.96"). The product may be mown before despatch to minimise damage to plants and as a result it may not be in flower when it is delivered. *All measurements are approximate.*
- **Growth** Turfonline Sedum Tray is a mix of 13 drought loving plants. The sedum species selected have been chosen to provide varied colour and texture throughout the seasons. These plants are grown into the tray and as such are fully integrated into the substrate. Turfonline Sedum Trays provide the growing medium, filtration and water storage required for a successful green roof. The main advantage over other system is their speed and convenience of installation. Turfonline Sedum Trays contain mature plants with full coverage at the time of despatch. Although this system was originally designed for green roof applications, they can also be installed onto the ground on a free draining surface to create self-contained ground cover. These trays were designed and manufactured in the UK and contain UK grown Sedum plants.
- **Typical Seed Mixture*** 100% sedum
- **Soil Classification** Contains bespoke FLL (Forschungsgesellschaft Landschaftsentwicklung Landschaftbau) compliant substrate.

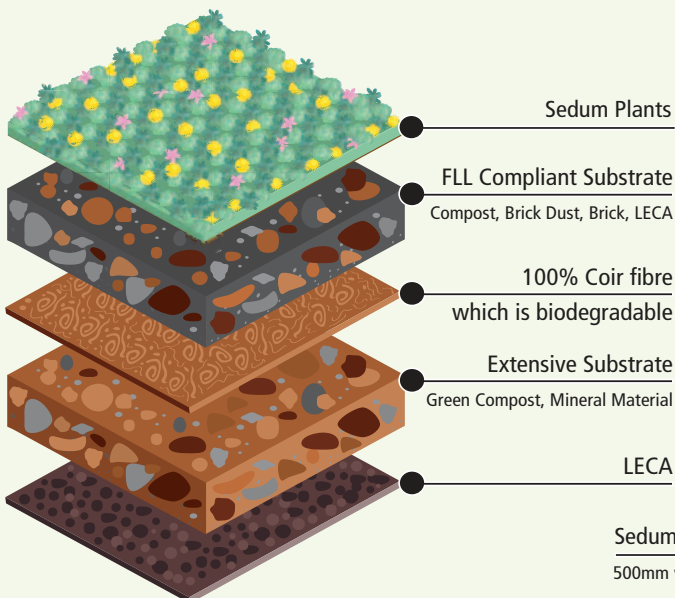

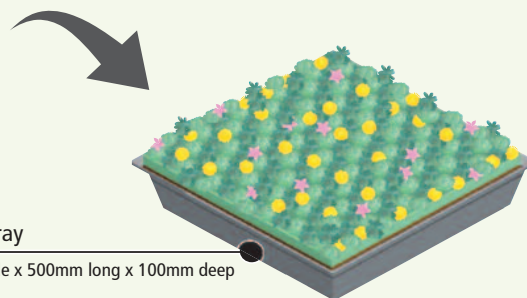
